## Covid updates

Please see the previous letter for our return to school updates.

Guidance has now changed and children, or those adults who have been double jabbed no longer have to self-isolate if they have been in close contact with a positive case. If we have a positive case in school, where your child is a close contact, we will email you asking you to take your child for a PCR test.

The guidance has not changed for people displaying symptoms. If your child has any Covid symptoms, we will ask you to collect your child and arrange for them to have a PCR test (not a LFD test). Again, please do not send your child into school if they are unwell.

If we have several cases, this will be classed as an outbreak. We will liaise with Warwickshire LA and Public Health England and may have to re-introduce some measures, such as staggered starts or face coverings in communal areas.

If your child has a positive case, please phone school in school hours on 02476 312221. After 5pm and over the weekend, please phone the Covid out of hours phone on **07856 907850**. Please leave a message if there is no answer– we will get back to you.
