Home Reading

Reading is one of the most important skills a person can learn. Reading skills are used every day by everyone. The more children read, the more fluent and confident they become. It is also important for children to be read to and to discuss stories.

We read lots in school and we listen to the children read on their own and in groups throughout the week. It is vitally important that all children continue these experiences at home. We are asking that every child reads at home for at least 10 minutes every day. That time quickly builds up and all helps to improve reading skills for life. Don't forget to record on the reading cards when you have read at home so that staff know when to change books. Children will now be able to change their books more regularly.

Attendance

With hopefully a year of less disruption we are aiming to improve our whole school attendance. We are aiming for 96% whole school attendance. Each week we will be sharing which class has the best attendance and which are punctual when arriving in school. They will be awarded either SAM or OTIS.

After School Clubs

Your child will have brought home a PE questionnaire, please return this to your child's class teacher next week as we will look at your responses to determine afterschool clubs we may be able to offer.
