In **Literacy** we will;

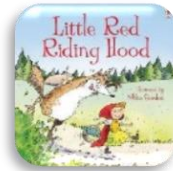
Be exploring non-fiction writing looking closely at food and plants and creating a fact file.

They will also explore the traditional tales of Little Red Riding Hood and Jack and the Beanstalk.

They will look at the characters from these tales.

Children will also be practising for their Phonics Screening Check in June.

Year 1 Summer Term



In **Maths** we will;

Continue to explore numbers up to 50.

Multiplication and Division – counting in multiples and creating groups of objects to count and share.

Fractions – identifying parts of a whole, equal and unequal parts and finding halves.

Position and Direction – Creating simple instructions of moves and turns

In **Science** we will;

Plants

Identifying and describing basic structures of plants in our world and creating our own butterfly gardens.

Seasonal Changes

Observe changes across the four seasons.

In **PSHE** we will;

Completing the Jigsaw Programme learning

In **Computing** we will;

Looking at using Purple Mash more confidently and exploring the world of coding.

In our **D&T** learning we will;

Exploring foods and where they come from.
Thinking about what makes a balanced diet.

Creating our own fruit salad / kebabs

In **Music** we will;

Having fun with musical improvisation. Using instruments to join in with creating a song.

In **History** we will;

Sequence 3 events and label simple timelines.
Learn more about what a famous person (Beatrix Potter) did.

In our **PE** learning we will;

Attack, Defend and Shoot – To play as part of a team.
To build basic rules and tactics.

Enrichment with Mr Leggett –

Children will complete Multiskills activities and take part in mini competitions.

In **RE** we will;

be learning about what makes different places sacred and why they are important.
