Tickets will be £5 per family. This will include bingo tickets, squash for the children and a hot drink for the grown ups.

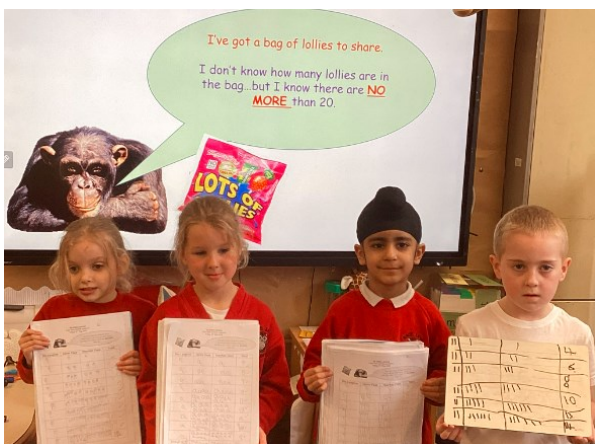
There will be other prize games on the night also.
