In **Literacy** we will;

In Communication and Language we will;

Be encouraging children to listen when others are talking.

To share their ideas about things they like and dislike, about their families and hobbies.

To communicate their needs with us.

In **Understanding the World** we will;

Explore the different families and homes that we live in.

Learn who are the people who will help us in our world.

In **Maths** we will;

Strengthening the children's understanding of pattern, matching and sorting in the world around them.

Developing their awareness of the numbers to 5 - reading, recognise, counting, ordering

Sing rhymes and read stories including numbers

In our **Personal, Social and Emotional** learning we will;

Learning the names of the children and adults in their class.

Be supported in playing with and alongside their peers for sharing and turn taking and helping to resolve conflicts.

Be encouraged to build up independence with items in the morning and getting coats and shoes fastened.

In our **Physical Development** learning we will;

Experience opportunities to develop large movements with balance and control.

Have opportunities to develop fine motor control to prepare them for becoming writers.
