Covid Updates

Face Masks for Parents/Carers

Thank you to everyone who has been continuing to helping us in our quest to minimise the risk of the Covid infection by wearing their face mask and keep their distance on the school site this week.

Following on from last years' positive response to our professionally produced Christmas cards, we have decided to give the children the chance to create their own cards again. This afternoon they will be bringing home their original picture with details of how you can order cards. School will benefit by earning a percentage of the funds taking from card sales. Learning Reviews

Our Learning Reviews take place with your child's teacher will give you the opportunity to find out how they have settled into their new class and to discuss progress and areas to work on at home and in school. These will be held on Tuesday 20th October and Wednesday 21st October after school.

This year we will be unable to hold these on a face to face basis. Instead we will be offering you the chance of a virtual meeting via a video call, or with a phone call. Video calls will take place via TEAMS and you will be sent an invite via your child's class group. Please see the separate letter to identify your preference. Please return your response promptly to secure your chosen date.

Use of Technology for Communication with Parents

Mrs Snape has been working very hard to create an online TEAMS parent group which she has called the Race Leys Parent Hub. This is a space where we can hold virtual parent meetings and learning reviews. You will be able to use this to take part in our learning reviews and to find out about how to help your child with their learning in the event of a further lockdown. Please see the video posted on the website and Facebook page to help you to know what to do and how to log in to the group.

Home Learning - where positive Covid case occurs in a bubble or Localised Lockdown

The school has to provide learning in case of a positive test within a bubble, for a local or national lockdown, or when children are isolating following a test. The expectation is that children will be able to continue their learning with you at home should any of these scenarios occur. It is the Government's and school's expectation that children can continue to learn.

Some of the learning will be paper based, however, some lessons will be broadcast live for pupils to take part in. There will also be some online activities for your child to complete.

In order to support you with how to go about home learning, Mrs Snape will be holding two virtual meetings for parents who wish to find out more. These will take place on Thursday 15th October. All parents will be sent an invite via the Parent Hub.

Safeguarding - Films

Over the last couple of weeks I have been approached by staff sharing concerns regarding children watching inappropriate films. The film 'It' and the character Pennywise have been raised on a number of occasions as well as the film Deadpool. These are 15 certificate films and not appropriate for our children to be watching - this includes trailers. As a school we have to log such incidents as a safeguarding concern. Please ensure that your child's devices are set to limit their use to age appropriate settings and monitor their activity online.

Open Day
